Lured by the promise of de Brétigny's riches, Manon does nothing to prevent the abduction.

INTERMISSION

ACT III Manon, now living with de Brétigny, has become the toast of Paris. When she learns that des Grieux is about to become a priest, she goes to find him. Des Grieux at first angrily confronts her, then gives in to her pleading and renounces his vows.

INTERMISSION

ACT IV Living with Manon, des Grieux's money has nearly run out. Accused of cheating at the gambling table, he is arrested. Comte des Grieux assures his son that he will be released soon, but Manon, as his accomplice, is taken away to prison.

ACT V Manon is about to be deported to America. Ill and exhausted, she begs des Grieux's forgiveness. As he assures her of his love, she dies in his arms.
