Put the events of *Così fan tutte* in order by numbering the sentences below from one to eight. Then, draw each scene in the empty boxes.



The opera's librettist, Lorenzo da Ponte, traveled extensively during his life: He was born in **Venice**, met Mozart in **Vienna**, and eventually moved to **New York City**, where he founded the Italian language and literature department at **Columbia College** (now University).
